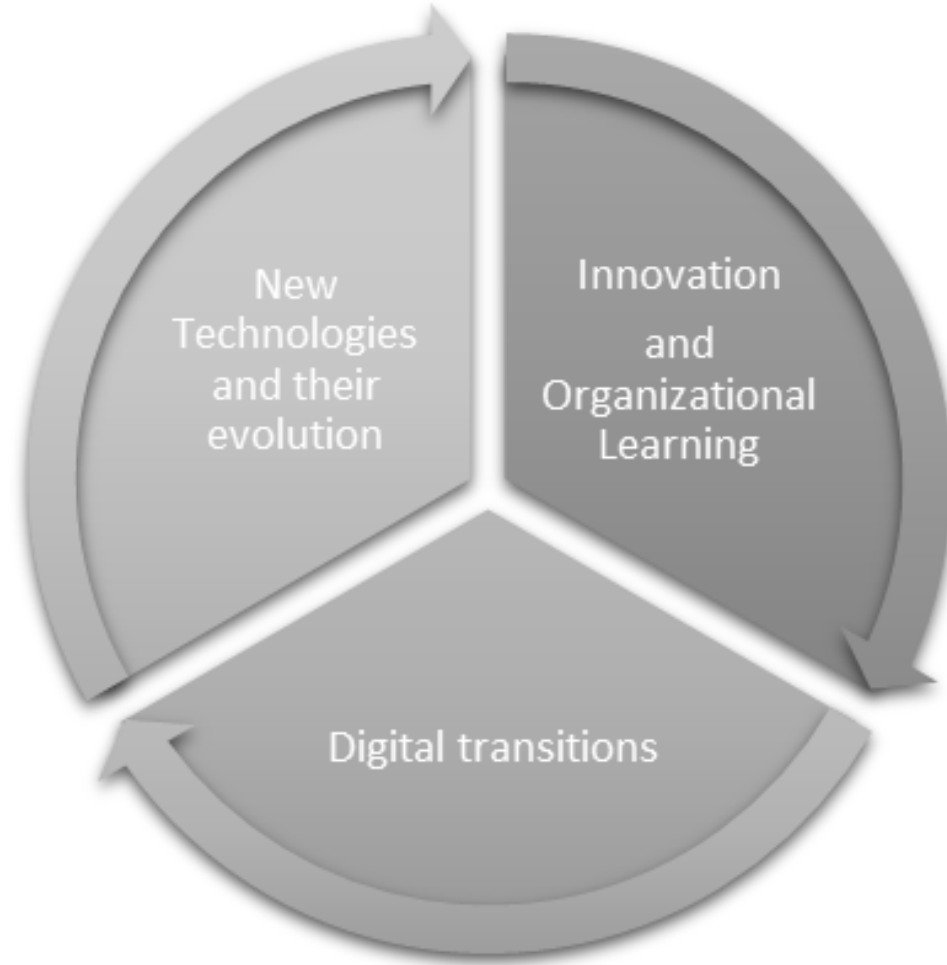

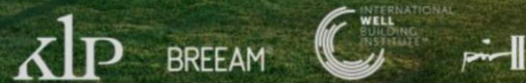

Vision and reality...

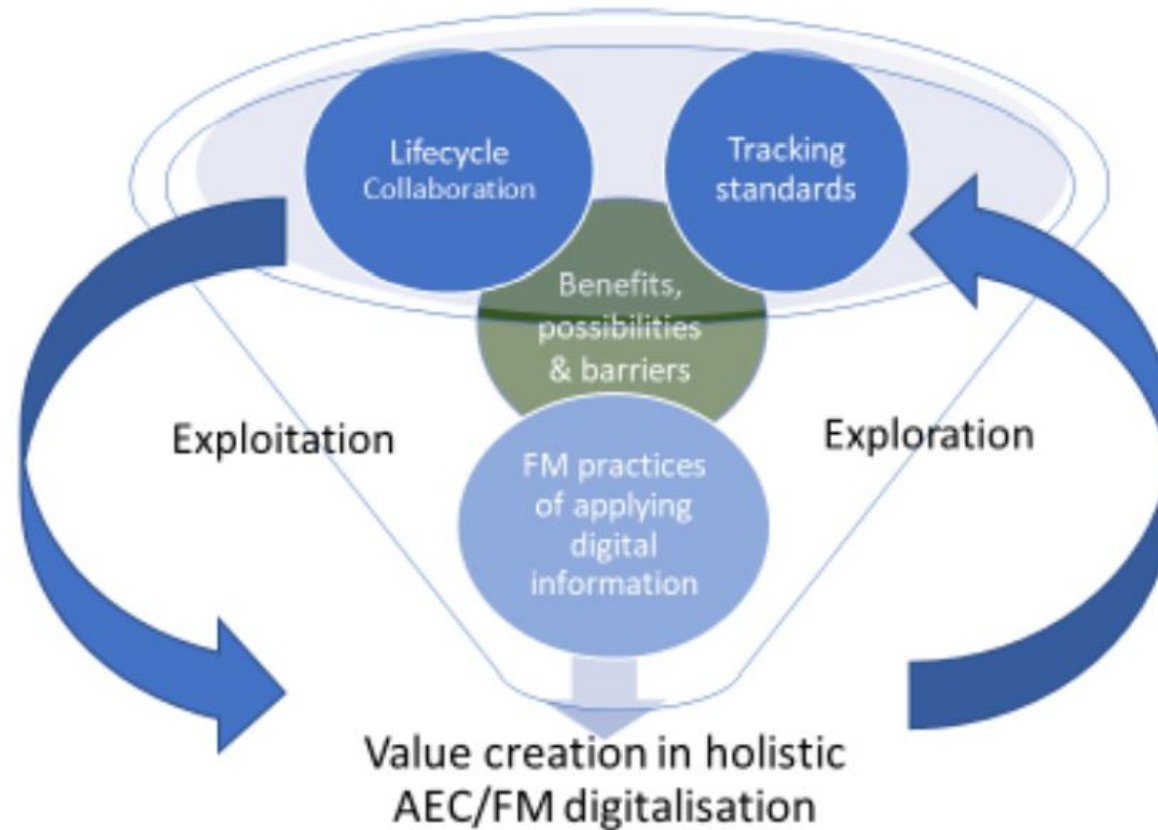

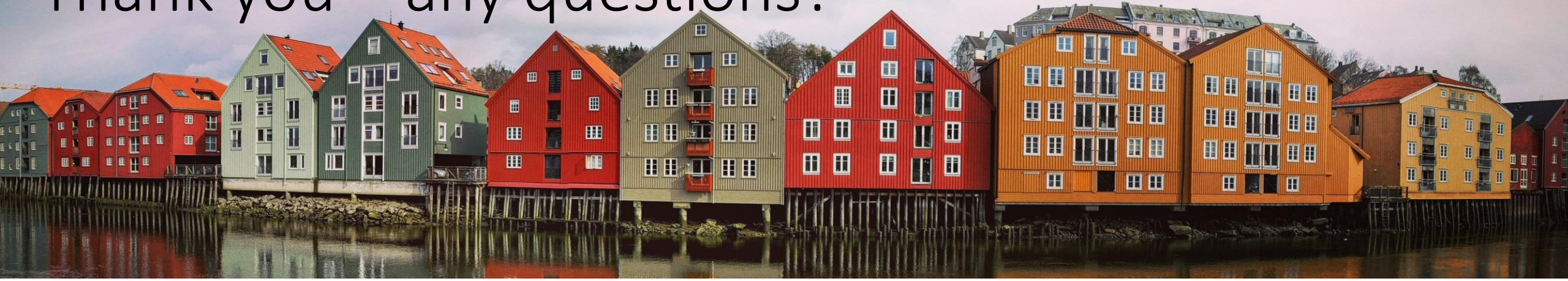
